SRINAGAR: A day after carrying their comatose 14-month-old daughter on their arms for seeking justice in Srinagar's Press Enclave in full media glare, the accused ASG hospital countered the claims of the family.

On Tuesday, Zikra Farooq was neither moving, nor able to see when her mother, Soliyah, longed to hear a word from her.

"My daughter is not able to walk or move her arms," Soliyah lamented. "She is the victim of medical negligence which damaged her brain at a private hospital in Srinagar." More On P8
