# \$453 Bn Investor Cuts India **Exposure On CAA, Kashmir**

NEW DELHI: The Western Asset Management Co is reducing its Indian government bond holdings on concerns over the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and the Jammu and Kashmir region clouding the economic outlook.

The \$453 billion investor, an affiliate of Legg Mason Inc, is diverting some of its funds into longer-dated Malaysian and Chinese debt, according to Desmond Soon, head of investment management for Asia ex-Japan, according to reports. It has an "overweight" position in India bonds.

The fund's view is that the protests over the controversial CAA may have temporarily taken the government's attention away from economic reforms. "It certainly distracts Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government from making the

# 5 More Mainstream **Politicians Set Free**

SRINAGAR: Jammu and Kashmir administration on Thursday released five politicians including three former legislators after keeping them in preventive detention for more than five months following abrogation of Article 370 of the Constitution.

Officials said the five mainstream politicians were released from preventive detention this afternoon.

#### The leaders who were released include Altaf Kaloo (ex-MLA National Conference), Showkat Ganaie (ex-MLC National Conference) and Niza-

muddin Bhat (ex-MLC PDP). Former mayor of Srinagar Municipal Corporation Salman Sagar (National Conference) and Mukhtar Bandh (PDP) were also released.

On December 30, five mainstream politicians, including two MLAs were released from detention by the **PAGE 10**
