IAF Rescues 9 Foreign, 98 Other **Trekkers In Ladakh**

Leh: Indian Air Force (IAF) has rescued 107 trekkers, including nine foreigners, in Ladakh region, which witnessed heavy to very heavy snowfall recently. official sources said on Friday. They said a message was received that 107 trekkers got struck in the higher reaches and needed immediate help. Later, the matter was taken up with IAF, they said, adding helicopters were pressed into service. "All the trekkers were rescued and taken to safer places," they added.

Train Chugs After Four Days

Jamaat Leader Slapped With PSA

Pakistan Ready For Plebiscite In Its Part Of Kashmir: Imran Khan

NEW DELHI: Prime Minister Imran Khan has reiterated that his country is ready to hold a referendum in Pakistan-administered Kashmir (PaK) to give people the right to decide whether they want to remain in the country or be independent.

"The best thing is (to) let the people of Kashmir decide. The people of Pakistan Kashmir and the Indian Kashmir. Pakistan is all ready to give them the right through a referendum or a plebiscite. Let them decide whether they want to remain with Pakistan or want to be independent. We're all for it," Khan said in an interview to Deutsche Welle's Editor-in-Chief Ines Pohl.

Jammu-Srinagar Highway Opens After 4 Days
