NEW DELHI:- The man who opened fire on students protesting against the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and the National Register of Citizens Thursday, had put up several posts on Facebook making his intentions clear that he would indulge in violence to "end" the Shaheen Bagh protests.

While scrolling through his Facebook posts, it was found that Gopal went live a number of times from outside the campus of Jamia and made a numbers of posts in which he mentioned that he was a lone Hindu in the area and none of the mediapersons covering the protest were Hindus.

In one of his posts, he also asked the people to help his family in his absence and as a last wish he wrote that his body should be wrapped in the saf-(NRC) in Jamia area here on fron cloth and people should raise the slogan of "Jai Shri Ram" on his last journey.

The BJP has accused the Congress and other opposition parties of inciting protests and violence against the law which, the ruling party has asserted, does not affect the citizenship of any Indian.
