

Rupee rises 19 paise against US dollar in early trade

MUMBAI: The rupee appreciated by 19 paise to 71.19 against the US dollar in opening trade on Tuesday, driven by positive opening in domestic equities.

The rupee opened strong at 71.24 at the interbank forex market then gained further ground to touch 71.19 per dollar, displaying gains of 19 paise against the greenback.

Forex traders said concerns over fiscal slippage and rising coronavirus outbreak fears still remain. The next trigger for the currency will be the Reserve Bank of India's monetary policy meeting, as its commentary on inflation and well as growth forecast would be keenly watched, they said.

The Reserve Bank of India is scheduled to hold its Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) during February 4-6, 2020.

Meanwhile, rising crude prices, foreign fund outflows and strengthening of the American currency weighed on the local unit.

On Monday, the rupee had settled at 71.38 against the US dollar.

Foreign institutional investors sold equities worth Rs 1,200 crore on a net basis on Monday, according to provisional exchange data.

The benchmark BSE Sensex was trading with gains of 476.82 points, or 1.23 per cent to quote at 40,349.13 while the NSE Nifty was trading at 11,851.55, up 143.65 points, or 1.23 per cent.

Meanwhile, Brent crude, the global benchmark, was trading at USD 54.57 per barrel higher by 0.40 per cent.

The 10-year government bond yield was at 6.50 per cent in morning trade.



Post Art 370, J&K Economy On Track: Kishan Reddy

NEW DELHI: Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, G. Kishan Reddy informed Parliament on Tuesday that agri operations have been proceeding smoothly in the Kashmir Valley ever since the revocation of Article 370 and formation of the union territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

In a written reply to a question regarding the economic impact of the abrogation, Kishan Reddy informed the Lok Sabha that 18.34 lakh MTs of apples were dispatched, up to

January, in financial year 2019-20.

Citing information provided by the government of Jammu and Kashmir, Kishan Reddy also said "the sericulture sector recorded a production of 813 MTs of silk cocoon in the year 2019.

"During the 1st three quarters of FY 2019-20, handicrafts worth Rs 688.26 crore were exported. Various tourism promotional campaigns have also been launched."

Members of the House were also informed that "Government of Jammu and Kashmir has informed that as per the Periodic Labour Force

Survey, last conducted for FY 2017-18, by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation of Government of India, the worker-population ratio for persons in the age group of 15 years and above for Jammu and Kashmir is 51 per cent."

Kishan Reddy said the full economic potential of Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh regions could not be realized for the last 70 years as the people of Jammu and Kashmir have suffered from terrorist violence and separatism supported from across the border for the past many decades.

J&K farmers to get Kisan Credit Cards by March 31

JAMMU: Farmers in union territory of Jammu and Kashmir will get Kisan Credit Cards (KCC) by March 31 this year, Chief Secretary B V R Subrahmanyam said.

Subrahmanyam chaired a meeting through video conference to review the progress under KCC Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-Kisan), disbursement of relief to affected farmers under SDRF, execution of MGN-REGA works and other issues. He expressed unhappiness over the slow progress in registration of beneficiaries.

"The process needs to be completed in a mission mode through a sustained drive to be launched by the DCs (Dis-

trict Collectors) in their respective districts to achieve 100 per cent coverage under the scheme by March 31, 2020 positively," he said.

Divisional Commissioner Kashmir and Jammu will closely monitor the progress to ensure accomplishment of the targets by the stipulated date, he added. He directed the DCs to have farmers engaged in poultry, fishery and other such sectors also included in KCC Scheme.

"The scheme may be linked with Aadhaar so as to remove duplication, if any", he added.

Divisional Commissioner Kashmir and Deputy Commissioners along with representatives of the lead bank and other officers attended the meeting.

Sensex rallies over 400 points; Nifty above 11,800

MUMBAI: Market benchmark Sensex surged over 400 points in morning session on Tuesday led by gains in index-heavyweights Reliance Industries, HDFC twins and ITC amid firm global cues. Reclaiming the 40,000 mark, the 30-share BSE index was trading 438.16 points or 1.10 per cent higher at 40,310.47. Similarly, the broader NSE advanced 120.15 points, or 1.03 per cent, to 11,828.05.

In the previous session, Sensex rose 136.78 points or 0.34 per cent to settle at 39,872.31, and Nifty gained 46.05 points or 0.39 per cent to close at 11,707.90. Meanwhile, on a net basis, foreign institutional investors sold equities worth Rs 1,200.27 crore, while domestic institutional investors purchased shares worth Rs 1,286.63 crore on Monday, data available with stock exchanges showed. HDFC was the top gainer in the Sensex pack, rising up to 2.5 per cent, followed by Reliance Industries, UltraTech Cement, Hero MotoCorp, ITC, IndusInd Bank and HDFC Bank.

Bharti Airtel posts Rs 1,035 cr loss in Q3 FY20

NEW DELHI: Telecom operator Bharti Airtel on Tuesday posted a consolidated loss of Rs 1,035 crore for the third quarter ended December 31, 2019.

The company had recorded a profit of Rs 86 crore a year ago.

The company's revenue, however, increased by 8.5 per cent to Rs 21,947 crore for December quarter compared to Rs 20,231 crore in the same period last year.

"While tariff revision undertaken in December 2019 is a welcome step towards repairing the financial health of the industry, we believe tariffs must go up further for enabling the industry to invest in emerging technologies," Gopal Vittal, MD and CEO, India & South Asia, Bharti Airtel said in a statement. Bharti Airtel India revenue rose seven per cent to 15,797 crore, compared to the same period of 2018-19. For the second quarter ended September 2019, Bharti Airtel had posted its highest ever net loss of 23,045 crore after provisioning of Rs 28,450 crore on account of the Supreme Court ruling on statutory dues.
