

Woman Duped Of rupees 22 Lacs By Online "Fraudsters", Case Registered

SRINAGAR: Cyber Police Station Kashmir Zone Srinagar registered a case against online fraudsters who duped a lady from Srinagar of rupees 22 Lacs on the pretext of having won a Lottery.

According to a statement issued here a police spokesman said, "A woman aged 35 years hailing from Srinagar reported to Cyber Police Station Srinagar stating that she was duped of rupees 22 lacs by online fraudsters on the pretext of having won a lottery."

Adding that the complainant stated that she received an email/SMS informing her that she had won a lottery and the prize money shall be assigned to her in foreign currency denominations.

The woman accordingly responded to the email and the fraudsters then communicated with the lady on her mobile phone.

"She was then asked to pay for various charges like registration fee, processing fee,



manner and are generally made to transfer huge amount of money either as money transfer or payment of taxes or transportation cost or either custom clearance etc. The victims generally receive a spam emails/SMS and respond to the same thereby end up paying money to some unknown persons for no return. Such crimes are generally carried out from faraway locations using different cyber masks.

Cyber Police Station advises general public to remain very careful while receiving such fraud SMS/Emails & Calls from unknown sources with regard to winning of unexpected prize money or lottery, job offers, installation of mobile towers, loan offers, insurance bonus offers etc. Community members are requested not to share any bank details or transfer funds to unknown persons in anticipation of higher returns." tax etc before the lottery prize money could be transferred to her. The lady then transferred the amount to the tune of rupees 22 lacs (approx) to various bank accounts. The lady after transferring the amount made efforts to call them but was unable to establish contact."

It is then the lady realised that she has been cheated by

the online fraudsters and no lottery amount was going to come through. "The lady accordingly approached the Cyber Police Station Kashmir Zone, Srinagar for lodgment of FIR. Accordingly a case FIR No. 02 of 2020 under relevant sections of law was registered at Cyber Police Station Kashmir Zone Srinagar." The statement

further reads. Further investigation in the matter is in progress.

"Pertinent to mention here that victims of such online frauds usually receive emails/SMS & Calls from unknown sources whereby they are informed that they have won a lottery worth millions. The victims are trapped in a phased

Tufail, a 12th class student and a resident of Saida Kadal, was hit by a teargas shell fired from a close range at him on June 11, 2010, near Gani Memorial Stadium in the old city's Rajouri Kadal area.

"We submitted before the court that our lawyer and Bar Association president Main Abdul Qayoom is under detention and could not appear before the court to plead the case. The court adjourned it and fixed next date of hearing April 11," said Tufail's father, Muhammad Ashraf Mattoo.

Chinese militants die in Kashmir: Report

NEW DELHI : Indian troops shot dead four Uighur militants from China's north western Xinjiang province in Kashmir last month, the Hindustan Times reported Wednesday.

According to the report, be-fore they died of their injuries, two Uighurs admitted they were trained by pan-Islamic jihad groups in Pakistan's Baluchistan province.

The militants also admitted they had infiltrated into Indian-controlled Kashmir from Paki-stan-controlled Kashmir with a group from the Lashkar-e-Taiba group, the newspaper said.

The militants were in Kashmir to observe "Lashkar's ongoing anti-India operations and then to head for Chechnya, the report said.

Information obtained from the militants was passed on to Chinese assistant foreign min-ister Wang Yi, who visited the Indian capital for the second round of the Sino-Indian secu-rity dialogue earlier this month, the newspaper reported.

During talks, the Indian delegation called for joint ef-forts to combat Islamic funda-mentalism, the news report said.

Xinjiang separatists — mainly ethnic Uighur Muslims — have been involved in fre-quent and bloody clashes with the Chinese authorities in re-cent years.

Uighurs, who speak a Turkic language and make up a large part of Xinjiang's popu-lation, have been linked to deadly bombings as well as ri-ots, most notably clashes in January 1997 which according to independent sources left as many as 100 dead.
