### Messi demands calm after chaotic 2 months for Barcelona

BARCELONA: Barcelona has been hit recently by a series of setbacks on the field and conflicts inside the club. And Lionel Messi has had enough of it.

"We have only had problem after problem since January. What we need is some calm and to think about soccer, to think about the games, and to try to improve," Messi told Spanish sports daily Mundo Deportivo in an interview on Thursday."

"At least we need to isolate ourselves (from the noise) because, if not, there are going to be complicated months ahead. ... We must be patient and hopefully we can turn this around." Since the start of the year, Barcelona has lost the Spanish Super Cup, been eliminated from the Copa del Rey, and ceded the lead in the

"I've learned that internal issues need to be resolved within the club, not in the media," the former player said.

Then came the oddest of all the Barcelona maladies when earlier this week the club severed its contract with an Internet services company that made negative comments on social media about people within the club.Reports by Spanish radio Cadena SER said those online comments included Messi, fellow player Gerard Piqué, as well as former coach Pep Guardiola.Messi said that he was still not sure what had happened.




