This scene depicted in the film of two pivotal cases of suicide which have come up - the first one at Kol kata's Jadavpur University due to ragging in the university campu and the second one in Chennai, due In this context, the classical soc ologist Emile Durkheim's study of Suicide (1897) remains a stalwart. Durkheim's study was based on secpolice. In his study, the functional ist bestowed four major observa tions which hold relevance even in he contemporary globalized world as two parameters to present four types of suicides, namely altruis tic, egoistic, anomic, and fatalistic suicide. He used four variables for his theory, marital status (bach underdeveloped country), religious orientation (protestant/catholic) nd sex (male/female)
Durkheim's study revealed tha mong bachelors and males than among married and females. It also evealed that suicide rates are less h underdeveloped countries in comAccording to the thesis, people with high suicidal thoughts are less inte grated into society. In contemporary ociety, egoistic and anomic suicides result from low integration of one in society and low regulation of in dividuals by society, as seen in the ase of Joy Lowbo. Apart from this family problems, marriage, and account for two-thirds of cases in ndia.
According to a 2018 report from

(WHO), suicide is one of the leadin causes of death in the world with suicide every year. Of these, about one-third occur among the youth. Suicide is one of the leading causes of death among $15-29$-year-olds. The

silent epidemic.

The approach not only mirrors the guidelines set forth by the WHO but also intricately weaves them
into India's unique socio-cultural context and its present social infrastructure. The core of this approach revolves around establishing ro bust surveillance mechanism
for monitoring suicides within for monitoring suicides within
concise three-year timeframe. Fur
hermore, a comprehensive plan is outpatient to institute psychiatric components of the District Mental Health Programme, ensuring the availability of vital suicide prevenwithin a commendable fise-year span. Actively encased within the framework of the Mental Health Act, this strategy serves as its prom inent outer layer.

A pivotal aspect of this strategy lies in its meticulous consideration of the pervasive stigma enveloping mental disorders and suicidal tendencies. An exhaustive brainstorming process has yielded prag-
matic guidelines, aimed at fostering responsible and sensitive media coverage of suicide incidents. Simultaneously, an innovative menconceived for integration into educational institutions. This pioneer ing endeavor holds profound significance, acting as a catalyst for elevating community awareness
and dismantling long-standing taboos. It epitomizes the progressive essence of Indian society, poised to set a compelling example on the global stage.

# Giving Employment A Boost: It Can’t Be Treated Merely As An Outcome Of Growth
