



The benchmark FAO Food Price Index in December was 10.1 per cent below its level on eyest ago and 28 per cent down from its all-time high scaled in March 2022, after Russia's invasion of Ukraine. But this story of global deflation is contrary to the Indian situation, where the official consumer food price index inflation ruled at 9.5 per cent in December. Curbs have been placed on sugar mills with regard to diversion of case juice and intermediates stage molasses for manufacture of fuel ethanoi, industrial-grade rectified spirit and potable alcohol. Simultaneously, imports of major pulses and crude edible oils have been allowed at zero or very low duttes till March 31, 2025. Nowthethanding all these supplyside measures, rice is retailing at an all-India average (modal) price of Rs 40 kg (Rs 35 a year ago), milled arhar (pigeon pea) at Rs 150 kg (Rs 10), chana (chickpea) at Rs 30 kg (Rs 66), sugar at Rs 45 kg (Rs 40) and onion at Rs 30 kg (Rs 25).

The government approach reflects an excessive pro-consumer policy bias. Saima Akhther, another local girl and a final-year student of Bachelor of Arts at Government Degree College Bandipora, said acquiring skills in today's era is very importrant, especially for girls. She said the centre is bringing a positive change to society as more girls are coming forward to enroll. "We did not have many opportunities to learn these skills. Tribal girls also aspire to be self-independent, but limited opportunities hinder their progress," Saima said. Maghool Dar, a trainer at the carpet centre, said the government aims to equip these girls with valuable skills, so that they earn a livelihood independently and, in turn, teach more girls in the future—(KNO)
